

Product Usage & Application Details

- <u>Two ways to apply</u>: Insta Protex can be sprayed directly on surfaces or it can be sprayed on a clean cloth first (until damp with solution) and then wiped on surfaces with the dampened cloth.
- For best results, use hot water to dissolve capsule fast and shake well. Be sure to shake solution before each use. (For your safety do not use boiling or extremely hot water)
- When using on dark colored surfaces, you may see a small amount of white residue after the solution has dried. If so, simply dampen a clean cloth with water and wipe the surface to remove any excess residue.
- Insta Protex can be used to spray, swab, rub or soak contaminated surfaces, including plastic, wood, stone, leather, glass and metal.

Frequently Asked Questions

Can I use Insta Protex in larger applications (more than 4 ounces)?

Yes. For large applications, multiple capsules can be used in a larger closed container. Use 1 capsule of Insta Protex for every 4 ounces of water you add to the desired container.

How long does Insta Protex last?

The powder capsule has a shelf life of 3 years. Once the powder capsule is activated by mixing with water, the sanitizing solution is highly active in the bottle for 10 days. Once the solution has been applied to a surface, it continues to sanitize the surface for 14 days following application.

The solution turned pink when it was first mixed and now it is clear. Is that normal?

Yes. The Insta Protex solution is pink when you first activate it with water and then it slowly becomes more clear or white in color over time.

Are there any safety precautions I should take while handling this product?

Once the Insta Protex powder capsule has been activated by water, it does not irritate the skin, generate toxic vapors nor damage clothing or surfaces. The dry capsules are not designed to be opened (only dissolved in water). If the dry concentrated powder gets outside the capsule, please use gloves and do not handle the raw material with bare hands.

The sprayer on my bottle stopped working. What should I do?

Try to 're-prime' the sprayer by holding your finger over the spray hole while simultaneously pushing the pump button up and down several times with your other hand. If this doesn't work, you may have a clogged or defective sprayer. If so, simply transfer your Insta Protex solution to a different spray bottle and contact us for a new, replacement spray pump.
